

## Kirkbymoorside Community Awards 2025 Guidance Notes

Kirkbymoorside Town Council is looking for 'Local Heroes', a group (voluntary organisation/charity/membership organisation) or individual that deserves recognition in one of the following categories:

- a. The voluntary organisation/charity/membership group of the year
- b. The 'quiet contributor' of the year
- c. The young person of the year (0 25 years of age)

As a voluntary organisation/charity/membership group they might have undertaken an initiative that has contributed to the life of the local community e.g. litter-picking, collecting for a food bank etc.

As an individual within a voluntary organisation/charity/membership group, they might have connected with their membership to increase participation or inclusivity. The 'quiet contributor' is the 'unsung hero' who might have done your shopping when you were ill.

And the young person of the year has looked out beyond their own world to make a positive difference to someone else's.

If you know this organisation, group or person, then please nominate them by completing the form and returning it to Kirkbymoorside Town Council by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025; either return it to the Library in hard copy or email it to the Town Clerk town.clerk@kirkbymoorsidetowncouncil.gov.uk.

Shortlisted nominees (or their individual representatives if a group) and their nominators will be invited to an award ceremony on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> September 2025.

Note: if there are several people nominating the same organisation/person, it may not be possible to invite all of the nominators to the awards ceremony. Selection will be based on the date that nomination forms were received.
