



Kirkbymoorside Community Awards 2025

Guidance Notes

Kirkbymoorside Town Council is looking for 'Local Heroes', a group or individual which/whom you consider deserve recognition in one of the following categories:

- a. The voluntary organisation/charity/membership group of the year
 - b. The individual and/or '*quiet contributor*' of the year
 - c. The young person of the year (0 – 25 years of age)
- a. The Group Award**
As a voluntary organisation / charity / membership group they might have undertaken an initiative that has contributed to the life of the local community e.g. litter-picking, collecting for a food bank etc.
- b. The Individual Award**
As an individual, this person can be someone from within a voluntary organisation/charity/membership group who has made a significant individual contribution to that group, a higher profile individual who has made a significant contribution to the community or a lower profile 'quiet contributor' who has made a significant contribution to the community.
- c. The Young Person Award**
The young person of the year has looked out beyond their own world to make a positive difference to someone else's.

If you know this organisation, group or person, then please nominate them by completing the form and returning it to Kirkbymoorside Town Council by Friday 5th September 2025; either return it to the Library in hard copy or email it to the Town Clerk (town.clerk@kirkbymoorsidetowncouncil.gov.uk).

Shortlisted nominees (or their individual representatives if a group) and their nominators will be invited to an award ceremony (date).

Note: if there are several people nominating the same organisation / person, it may not be possible to invite all of the nominators to the awards ceremony – selection will be based on the date that nomination forms were received.
